Re: Application for Fur Harvest, Fur Management and Conservation Course

Persons applying for their first trapping licence, or those who have not held a trapping licence in the past five years, are required to complete the Fur Harvest, Fur Management and Conservation Course. Following the course, each student will be subjected to a written and practical field examination.

Certified instructors in conjunction with the Ministry of Natural Resources & Forestry and the Ontario Fur Managers Federation will be holding the Fur Harvest, Fur Management and Conservation Course. The course consists of 40 hours held on weekends over a two-week period.

Course dates are: November 15th, 16th, 17th & 22nd, 23rd, 24th, 2019. Full course hours must be taken.

You should bring a notebook and pen each day, as well as suitable clothing for the outdoor sessions. Class will break at noon. You may wish to bring a lunch and beverage.

An application for this course is attached. Course fee is **\$250.00** which includes your manual & examination. Course is limited and based on first come, first served. Application and payment of **\$250.00** must be submitted no later than **November 5, 2019**.

The successful completion of the Fur Harvest, Fur Management and Conservation Course does not guarantee a person a place to trap or a trapping licence. In order to trap, you must also be licenced to hunt.
