A new program is coming to Gull Bay!! David Peterson NP, from the Dilico Health Care Services FWFN introducing the Suboxone program in GBFN-KZA.

The program will be open to;

- Anyone who is currently on Suboxone
- Anyone wanting to switch to injectable Sublicade
- Anyone who has questions regarding the program
- If you currently use Methadone and would like to switch to Suboxone

David and his team will be here on Thursday February 24, 2021. Appointments will start at NOON. During your appointment David will be discussing how the program will work. You will have the availability of Social Workers, Physiologist for counselling, goal setting or other needs. The Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) nurses will be here to provide Direct Observe Therapy (DOT) as well as dispense the ordered medication.
