

Notice of Nomination Meeting for the Gull Bay First Nation Elections November 2021

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Electors of the Gull Bay First Nation Indian Band will be held in Gull Bay First Nation at the Gull Bay Recreation Hall on Saturday the 2nd day of October 2021, beginning at 2:00 p.m. and lasting for three (3) hours, for the purpose of nominating a Chief and Candidates for the positions on the Band Council of the said Band for the next ensuing term. There are Ten (10) Councillor positions and one position for Chief available.

Please note that any voter may nominate by using the mail in nomination form that is included in this package. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination form with a complete, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the Electoral Officer before the time set for the nomination meeting OR you may nominate your choice of Chief and Councilors at the nomination meeting. Other Mail-in nomination packages may be requested from the Electoral Officer 1-807-707-3747. Mailed nominations not received by the Electoral Officer before the time set for nomination meeting are void. Please note that this nomination needs to be seconded and the candidate nominated needs to be in attendance at the nomination to accept the nomination by the closing of the nomination meeting.


In accordance with subsection 9(4) of the Act, an elector must not nominate more than one candidate for each position filled.

Please note that the Council of Gull Bay, by Resolution, imposed a candidate fee of \$250.00 for both Chief and Council positions. Once nominated, a candidate must remit to the Electoral Officer or Deputy Electoral Officer, by 6:00pm Tuesday October 5th a signed declaration accepting the nomination and attesting to their eligibility to be a candidate under the Act plus the applicable fee of \$250.00 in form of cash, certified cheque, money order or electronic transfer payable to the Electoral Officer.

In the event that an election is called for the Gull Bay First Nation, an Election Poll will take place at the Gull Bay First Nation Recreation Hall in Gull Bay on Saturday, November 20, 2021 with the polls opening at 9:00am and closing at 8:00pm. Also, the advance poll will take place at the Valhalla Inn, Viking Room at 1 Valhalla Inn Road, Thunder Bay, Ont., P7E 6J1 on Saturday, November 13, 2021 with the polls opening at 9:00am and closing at 8:00pm.

To receive a mail out ballot, the elector must make a written request to the Electoral Officer with a copy of identification that clearly represents the elector's identity. These forms can be requested from the Electoral Officer, at the Nomination Meeting, in the Nomination Mail out Packages, or at the Band Office.
