Traditional Healing Clinic

Dilico Anishinabek Family Care will be offering a bi-monthly Traditional Healing Clinic lasting four days with a Traditional Healer, Cultural Coordinators, and a Traditional Liaison.

The Traditional Healing Clinics will offer:

- Traditional Feast on Day 1 (afternoon/evening arrival), Day 2, Day 3 (midday), and Day 4 (midday/departure)
- Washdown Ceremony on Day 1 – in the evening at Eatons (Court Street)
- Sweatlodge on Day 2 – in the afternoon at Anemki (Fort William) location
- Traditional Healing walk-in sessions on Day 3 (all day) at Eatons (Court Street)
- Traditional Teachings/ Activity – Day 3 (all day) at Eatons (Court Street)

There will be 10 spots available for people to attend; travel, meals and accommodations will be provided by Dilico Anishinabek Family Care. Please inform on universal referral form, special preferences for accessibility and special diet. Hotel will be booked in downtown Port Arthur area close to Dilico Court Street office location. Dilico Health Services can assist with signing off letters for those who require as per NIHB for confirmation of conditions and/or escorts.

What is provided by Dilico:

- Travel from home community and return - travel arranged on own for private car, if wanting to take the bus please let us know and can book for you.
- Participants travelling in from community and staying at hotel – 3 nights
- Meals supplied at Traditional Healing Clinic – 4 Feasts (evening first day, 3 midday feasts on days 2, 3 and 4).
- Breakfast and other meals will be covered up front by Dilico, but will require client to sign NIHB reimbursement form.
- Nutritional snacks and refreshments throughout 4 days
- Local transportation to Sweatlodge at Dilico Head Office site on Fort William First Nation and back to hotel or address in city.
- Local transportation to and from hotel or address in city, hotel will be close to office if participant chooses to walk.

Applications submission date:
