

On-Reserve Housing Interest Survey

Who can complete a “Housing Interest Survey”?

Housing projects are open only to registered status members of KZA – GBFN. This survey is reflective of a fully OPEN process – meaning you may currently reside either in Gull Bay OR outside of the reserve. The only consideration that needs to be stressed in that those members expressing interest are committed to living in GBFN on a full-time and permanent basis and have no access/ownership to secondary housing.

At least one member of the household must be 18 years of age or older and able to live independently. Know that there are a maximum number of occupants that each type of unit can hold and are requirements regarding age/gender sleeping standards.

Understand that eventual occupancy of constructed homes in GBFN have usually been geared to specific criteria which is contained within focused funding proposals. With this in mind, by providing accurate information, you will ensure that the identification of yourself and/or your family (as potential future GB home occupants) is the most well-suited to both the size and the terms/conditions outlined in any particular project.

How/Why do I submit a Housing Interest Survey?

The information gathered will assist KZA in supporting Chief and Council’s claims to Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) as to exactly how many GB members are in dire need of housing and how many GB members have become, or remain, disconnected - due to historical/culminating effects of ISC housing shortfalls. Based on population increases, the survey will also forecast the need for community infrastructure upgrades such as roads/lots, electrification, water/sewer, recreation and educational facilities.

The information collected in this survey is for the purpose of demonstrating to ISC the need for further/continued on-reserve housing AND renovation funding.

Eligibility for occupancy will be determined through a transparent application and selection process after ISC project funding commitments are received.

in advance of any occupancy applications and/or vacancy notifications.**
